*Finally, I hope this placement report helps prospective students better understand what Masters' Union has to offer and our deep commitment to shape careers.*

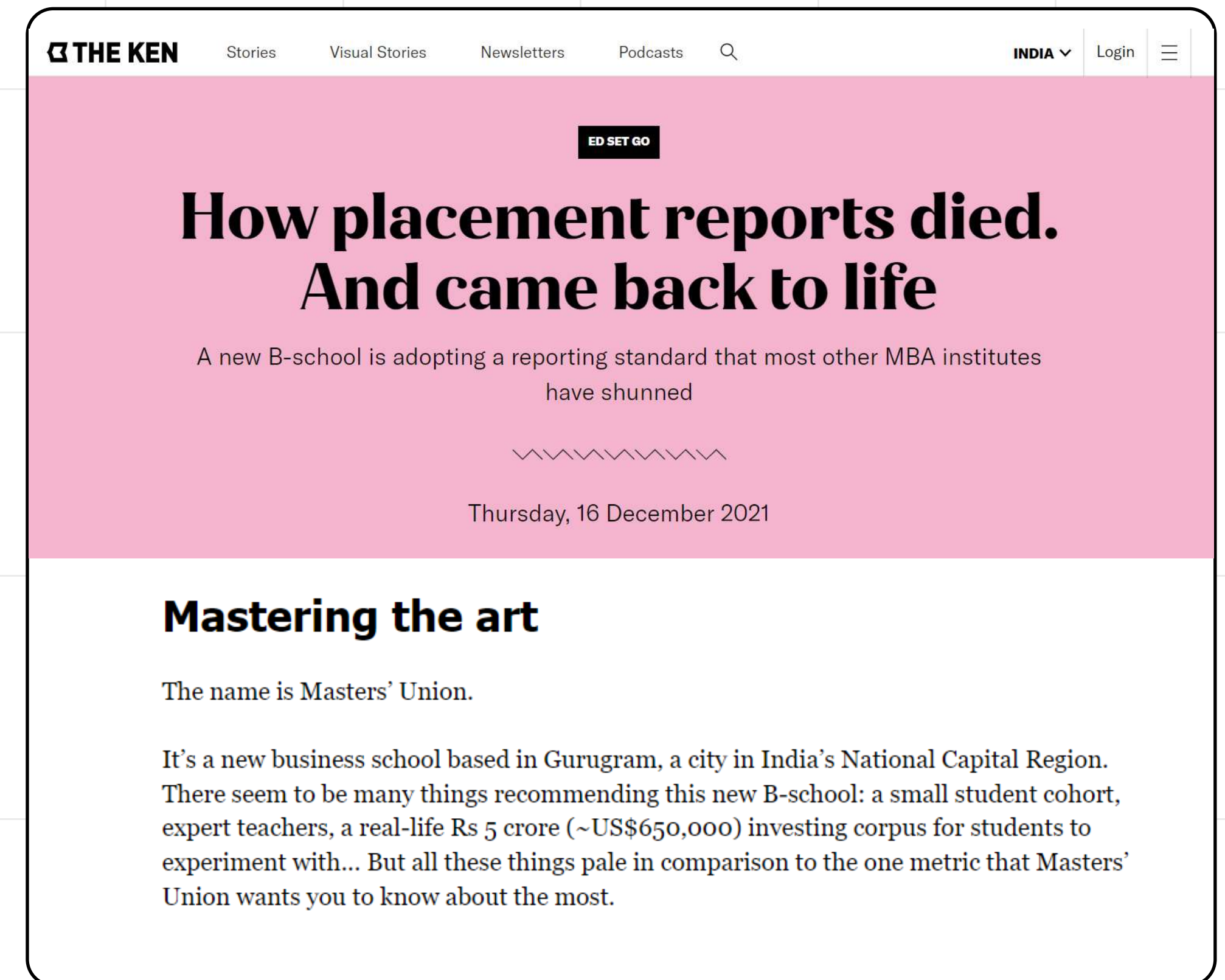

Re: Audit of Placement Report for placements of Post Graduate Programme in Technology and Business Management (PGP TBM)- Cohort of 2022.

We have audited the Placement Report prepared by you on the final placements (based on the offers received and accepted on campus) of students of the Cohort of 2022 of the PGP TBM program of The Masters' Union School of Business. The Placement Report is the responsibility of The Masters' Union School of Business. Our responsibility is to validate the information provided in the report with the relevant documentation and comment on the Placement Report's conformance with the figures in the relevant offer letters.

In this context, we confirm the following:

1. For the purpose of the verification, we have obtained all the information and explanations which to the best of our knowledge and belief were necessary.
2. The validation of information presented in the report is based on communication received by Masters' Union School of Business from the recruiting companies.
3. The CTC mentioned includes the fixed component, the variable component and ESOPs/ restricted stock units (RSUs) component. For the purpose of calculating RSUs, in case the company has clearly given a vesting schedule, only the RSUs vesting in the first year have been used for the purpose of calculating CTC. However, certain recruiters have offered upfront RSUs and have not mentioned any vesting schedule and hence, the entire RSUs have been considered for calculation of CTC. Since the details of the vesting schedule of RSUs were not available in such cases, the actual earnings/ annual CTC for such students could not be determined.
4. The information in the attached report has been verified on the basis of the offer letters and copies of relevant emails from the recruiting companies, provided by Masters' Union School of Business. BWA has not separately verified the authenticity of such supporting documents.
5. We have audited the salary figures as given below

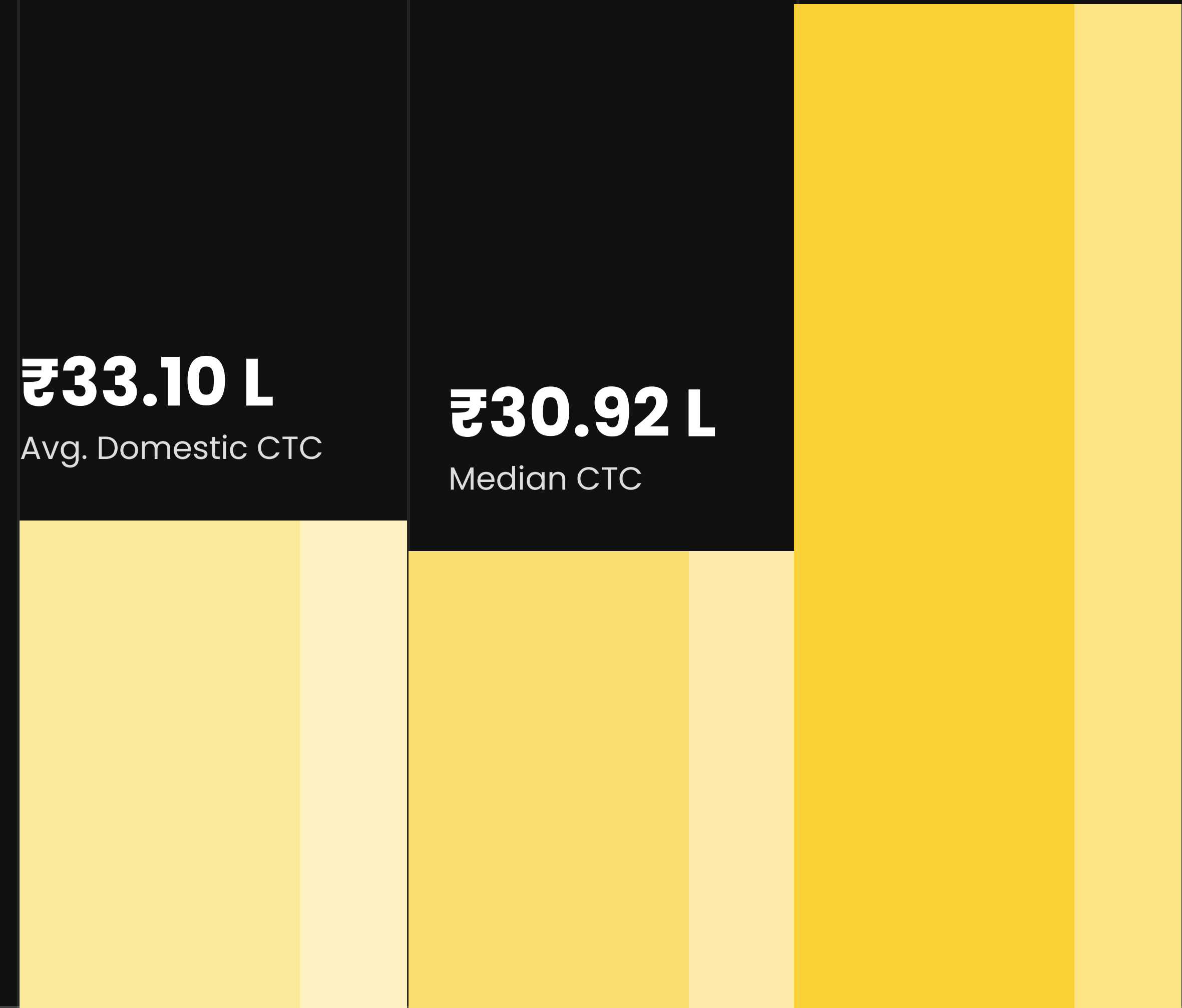

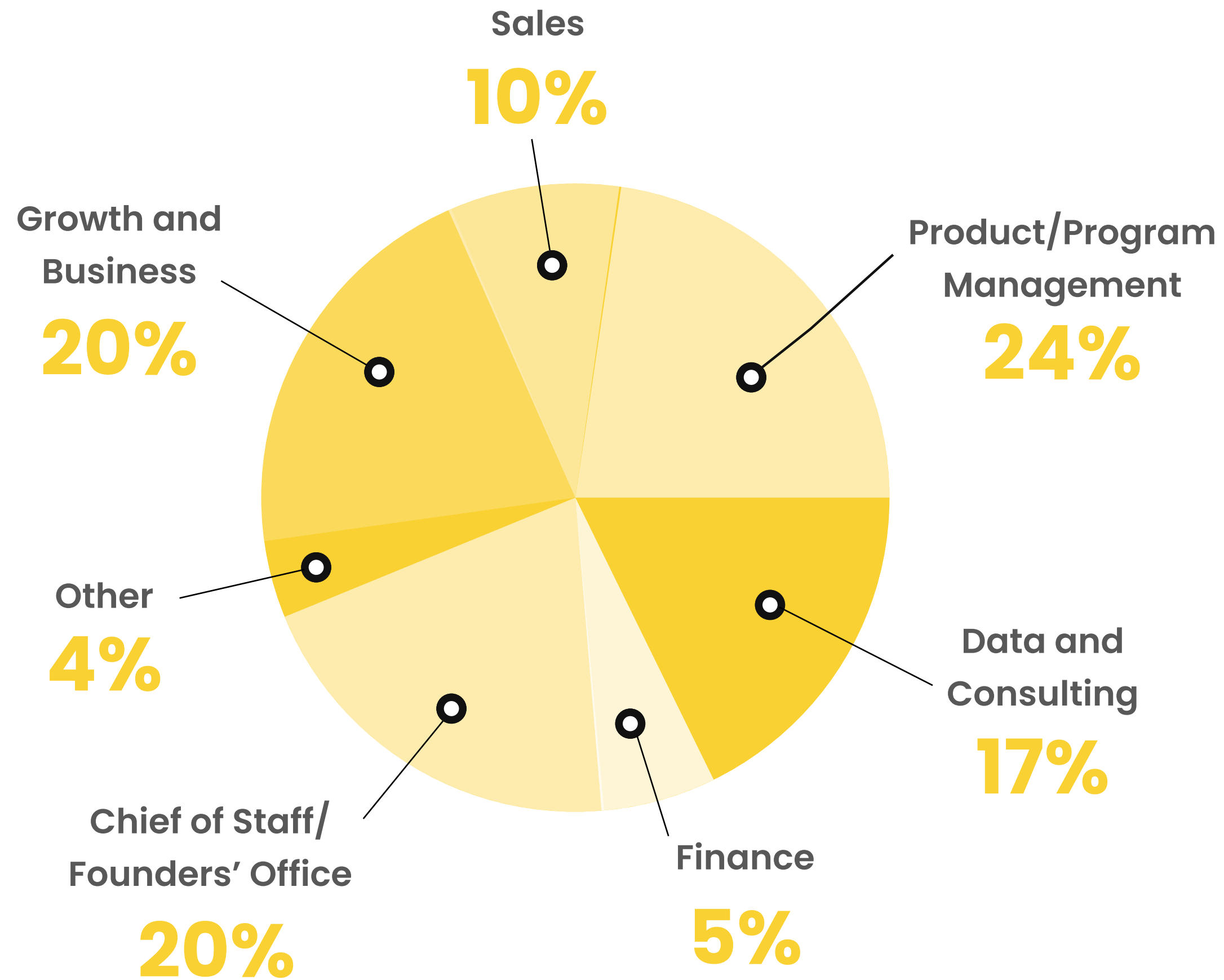


Sector Wise **Offers**

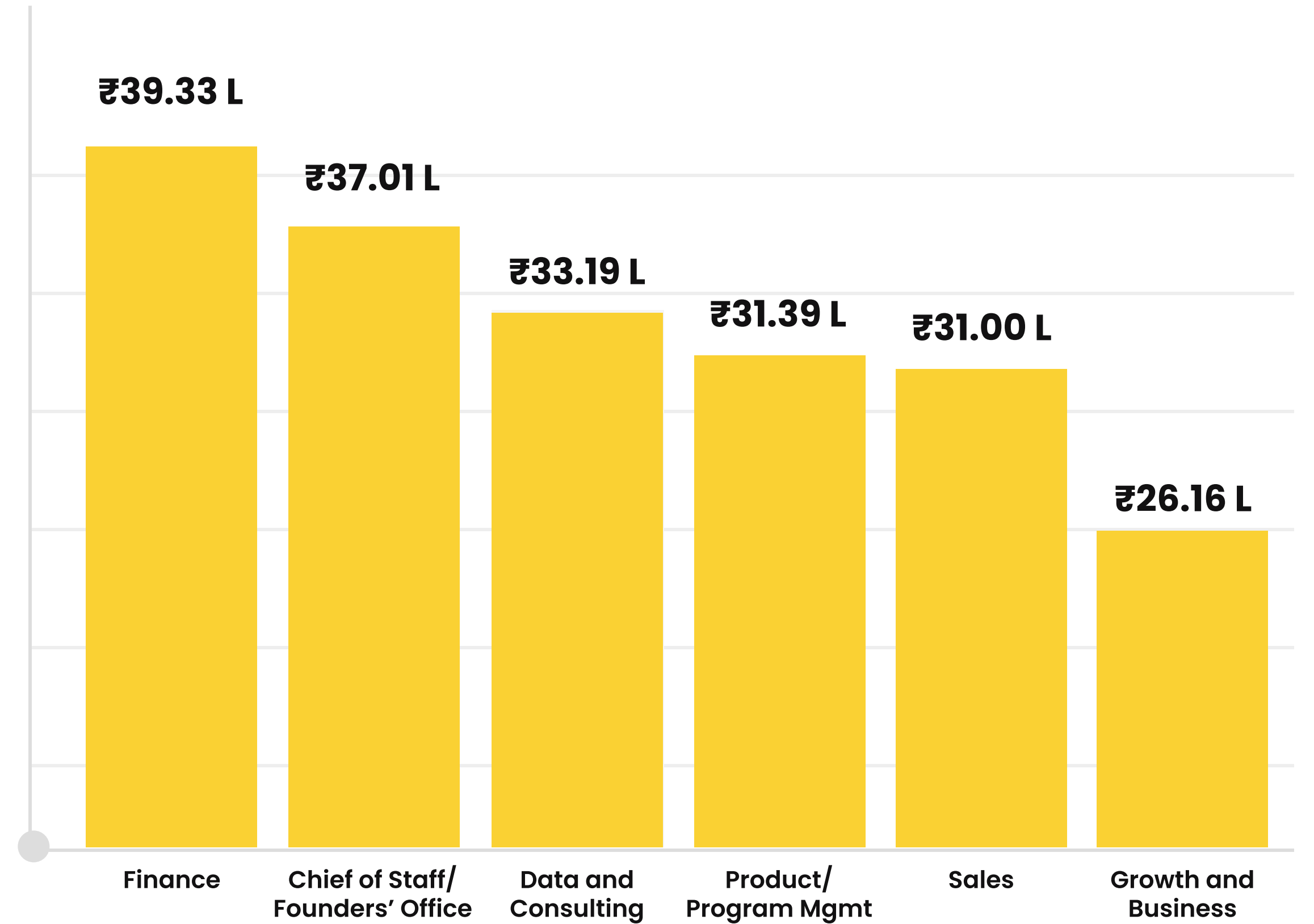


Sector Wise **Avg. CTC**

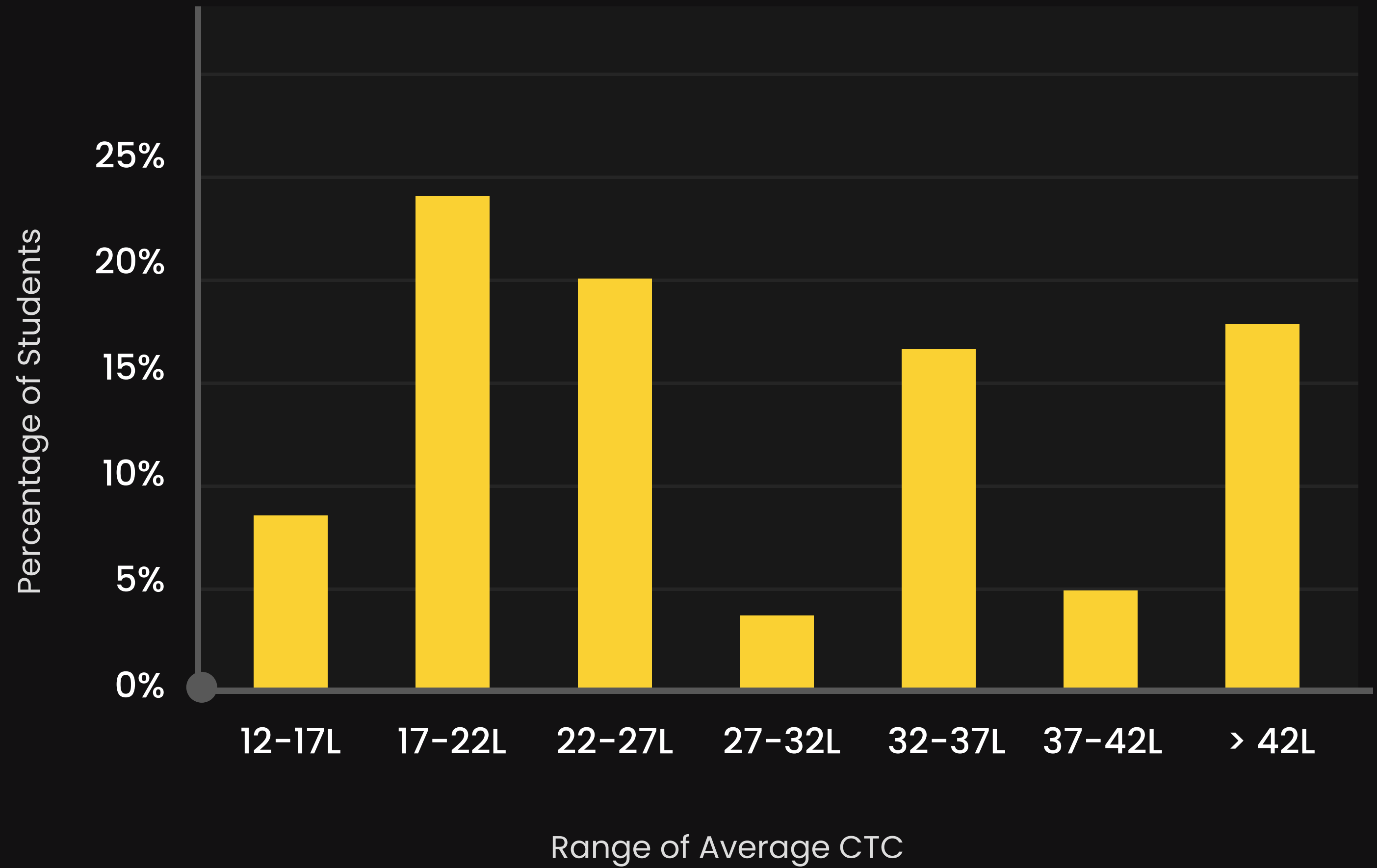
# CTC Components

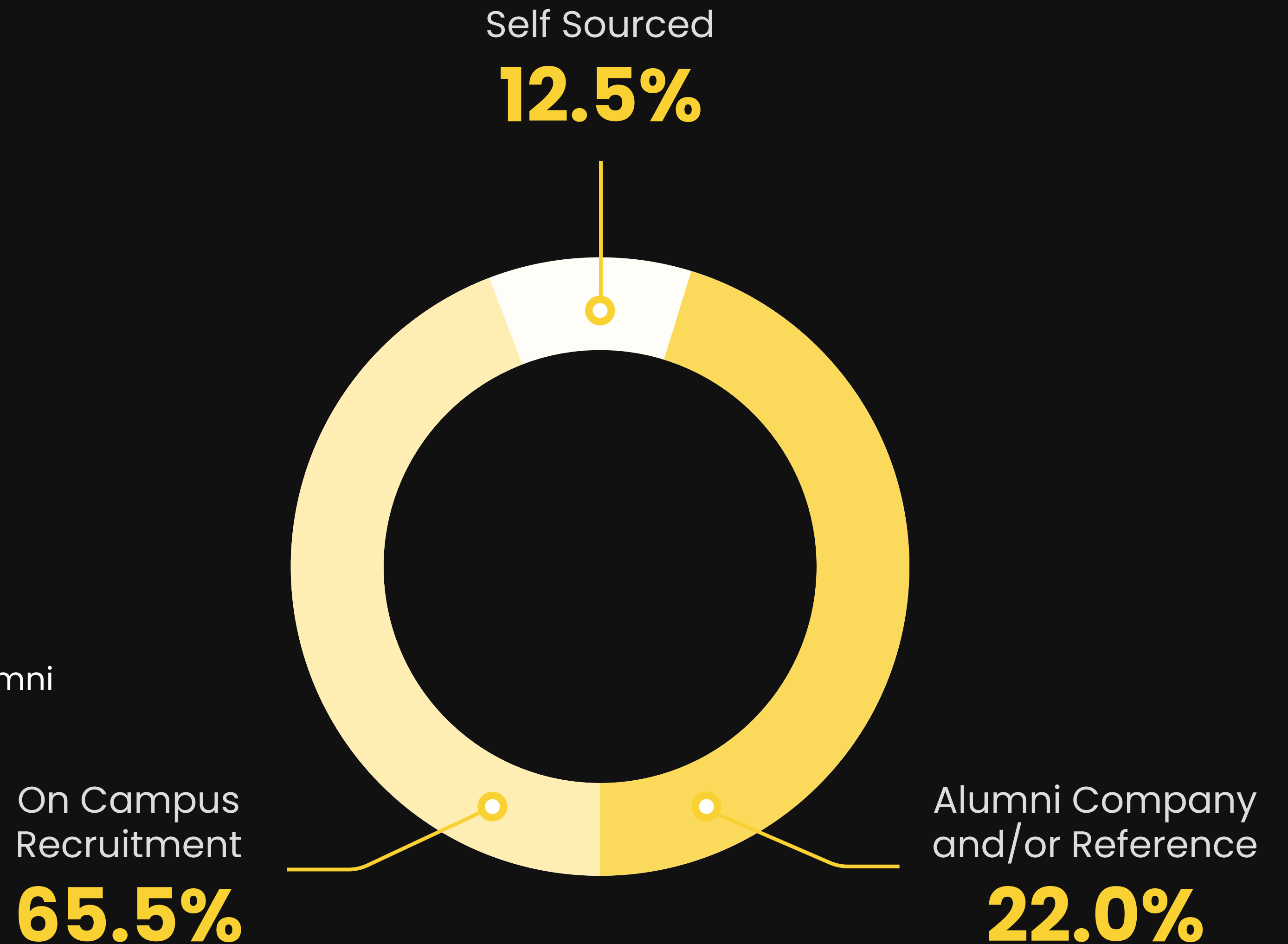

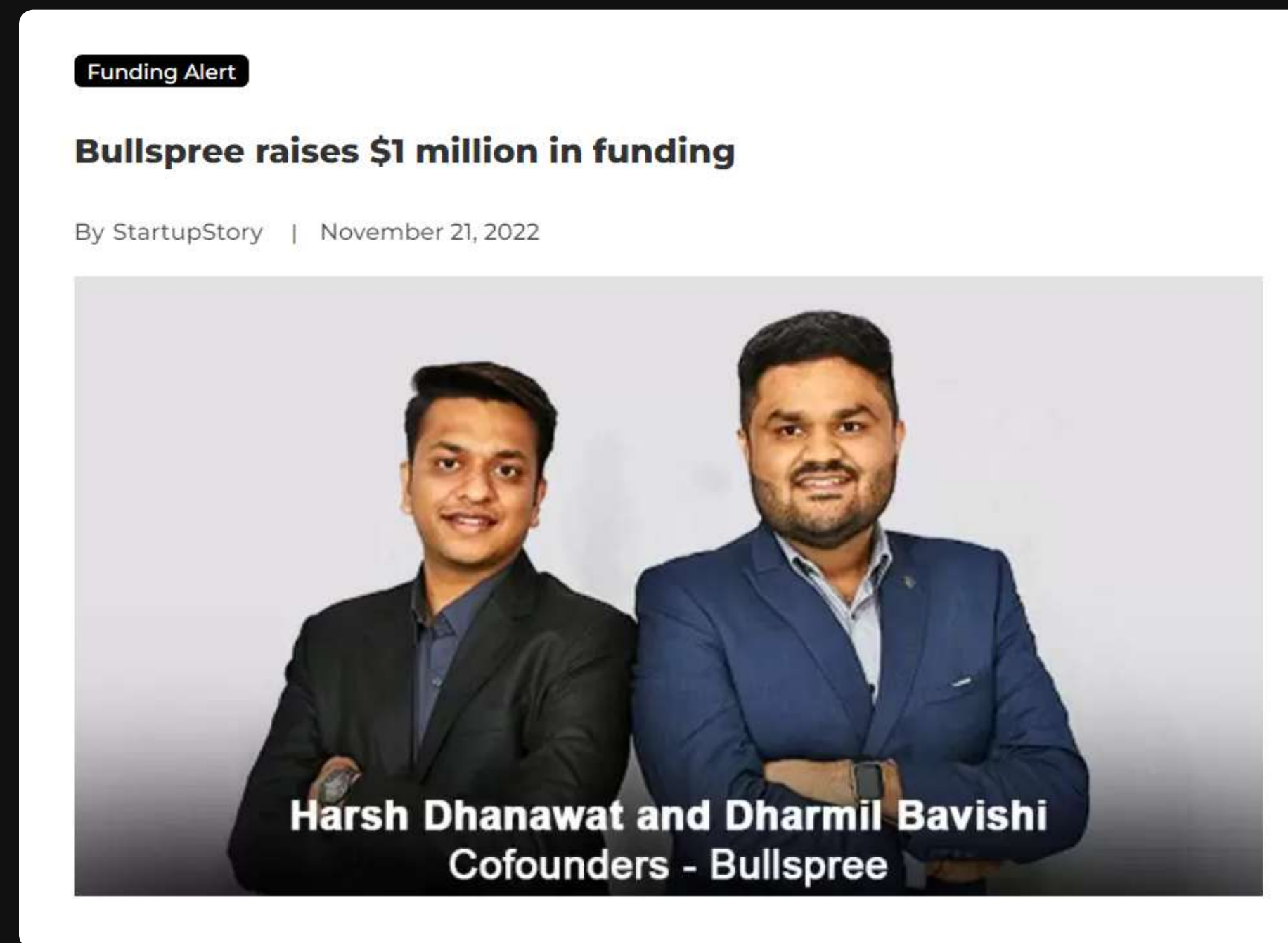
